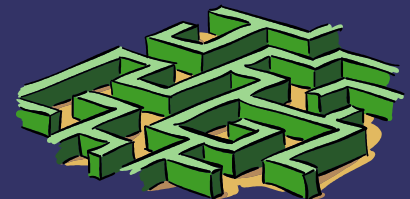

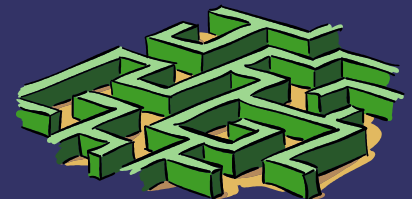
The Apostleship of the sea:

parrot.



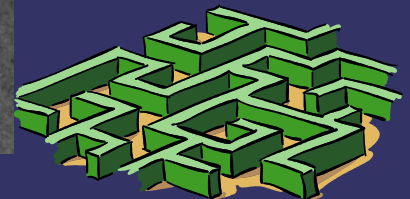
Pirates (2)

- ➔ They go around robbing ships, capturing sailors and selling them as slaves



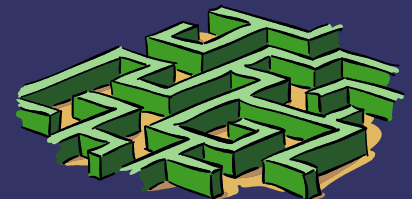
My Joke Machine
